






Proceed with caution and attend, Cows may be coming round that bend, Or carts, piled high with bulky loads— Go carefully on country roads.

CRAKEHALL To KIRKBRIDGE STARTING POINT:

VILLAGE GREEN OUTSIDE THE CHURCH


TIME: APPROXIMATELY ³/₄ HOUR

CONDITIONS: FIELD AND ROAD

CIRCULAR

FROM THE CHURCH HEAD FOR THE SOUTH EAST CORNER OF THE GREEN AND PASS BETWEEN THE OLD BARN AND HALL FARM COTTAGE BEARING RIGHT ALONGSIDE A WALL.

THE PATH TURNS SHARPLY LEFT AND PASSES ALONG THE END OF THE GARDEN OF THE OLD BARN TO A GATE. CROSS A SMALL FIELD TO A SECOND GATE.



PASS THROUGH THE GATE AND HEAD ACROSS THE FIELD BEARING SLIGHTLY RIGHT AND AIMING FOR THE GATE TO THE RIGHT OF THE WOOD.

FOLLOW THE PATH ALONGSIDE THE WOOD, CROSS OVER A STILE AND FOLLOW THE PATH ALONG THE HEDGE TO ANOTHER STILE IN THE CORNER.

CROSS OVER THE STILE, GO THROUGH A SMALL FIELD TO THE NEXT STILE.

CROSS OVER THIS, THEN BEAR LEFT ALONGSIDE THE HEDGE. ***

THE PATH LEADS TOWARDS A WIDE GATE, WHICH IN TURN BRINGS YOU TO THE ROAD AT KIRKBRIDGE. TURN LEFT AND FOLLOW THE ROAD BACK TO CRAKEHALL.

*** BY TURNING RIGHT AT THIS POINT THE BRIDLEWAY LEADS TO BEDALE.
